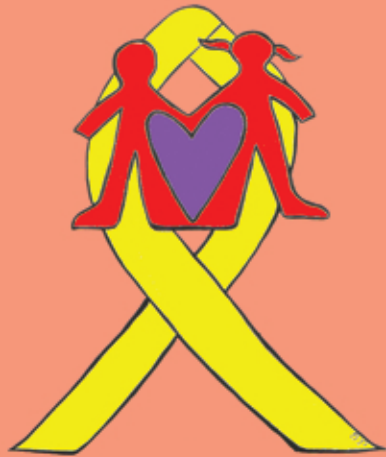

Spreading Hope

Due to the overwhelming generosity of the community of Scottsboro, Sadye's Fund has been able to assist the following three families in the first year of its existence.

Kelsie Teal, daughter of Michael and Christina Teal, is a senior at Scottsboro High School. As school starts this year, Kelsie is busy enjoying her last year in school and looking ahead to her future. But this time last year, Kelsie was in the fight of her life. In September 2009, Kelsie was diagnosed with AML leukemia. Kelsie went to St. Jude's in Memphis, TN for her surgery and chemotherapy treatments which lasted approximately six months. When Kelsie's treatments ended in March 2010, she was cancer free. Kelsie is now in the maintenance phase of her treatment which includes frequent check ups in Memphis.

Maddie Gamble, daughter of Chris and Kerri Gamble, is an eight year old girl from Hanceville, Alabama. Maddie was diagnosed with Epithelioid sarcoma in April 2010. Maddie is one of the youngest people ever diagnosed with this very rare cancer. Maddie also went to St. Jude's for her surgery and radiation treatments which concluded in July 2010. Currently, Maddie has no new tumors in her body, and is having check ups every three months to monitor her situation.

Ehrren Gillespie, son of Eric and Wrenne Gillespie, is a two year old boy from Harvest, Alabama. Ehrren was diagnosed with a malignant brain tumor in December 2009. Ehrren is also a patient of St. Jude's. He has had several surgeries, chemotherapy treatments, and is now undergoing a special type of radiation treatment in Jacksonville, Florida. Ehrren and his family continue to do everything that they possibly can to beat this terrible disease that is cancer.
